SCIENCE BEYOND THE TEXTBOOK

Learning becomes meaningful when concepts are observed, tested and applied.

Students explored scientific concepts through Density Determination, Solution Preparation, Cell Division Diagram Activity, Refraction through a Glass Slab, Chemical Reaction Demonstration, Motion Graph Analysis, and a Human Reproduction Model. These practical experiences helped students connect classroom concepts with observation and application.

01 CELL DIVISION DIAGRAM ACTIVITY

Students visualised the stages of cell division through diagrams and guided explanation, strengthening conceptual understanding through observation.



02 REFRACTION THROUGH A GLASS SLAB

A hands-on optics demonstration helped students observe the path of light and understand refraction through direct experimentation.



03 MOTION GRAPH ANALYSIS

Graphs turned motion into something students could see, discuss and interpret, connecting mathematical representation with physical movement.

Mathematics • Expression • Real-World Learning

Across Mathematics, Humanities and Commerce, students moved beyond routine classroom learning through practical tasks, discussion, interpretation and real-world simulations.

01 MATHEMATICS IN ACTION

Mathematical thinking was strengthened through Graph Plotting, Coordinate Geometry Practical, Mathematical Quiz Competition, and exploring Calculus in Real Life, encouraging students to approach concepts with greater logic, accuracy, and confidence.



EXPRESSION, ANALYSIS & CREATIVITY

A Hindi Role Play encouraged students to express ideas creatively, while Source-Based Historical Analysis helped senior students engage with historical information through interpretation and evidence.

02 REAL-WORLD LEARNING

Commerce and Humanities students explored practical scenarios through a Market Survey, Business Plan Presentation, and Election Process Simulation, developing communication, decision-making, analytical thinking, and leadership skills.
